RESOLUTION 02-03-30-88

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROPOSAL REQUESTING ASSISTANCE UNDER THE FAMILY VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND SERVICES BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, fully authorized to act in behalf of its' members; and,
- WHEREAS, the Office of Human Development Services has available program funds to assist tribal governments in providing immediate shelter and related assistance to victims of family violence through Public Law 98-457.42, entitled the "Family Violence Prevention and Services Act"; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has a desire to participate in the Family Violence Prevention and Services Program; and,
- WHEREAS, the securing of additional funds would greatly assist the tribal government in establishing, maintaining and expanding programs and projects to prevent family violence and to provide immediate shelter and related assistance for victims of family violence and their dependents.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve and authorize the submission of a proposal to the Office of Human Development Services for financial assistance under the provisions of Family Violence Prevention and Services Act.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution, and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
