RESOLUTION 02-03-45-88

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROPOSAL REQUESTING CONTRACT FUNDS FROM THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to contract with Federal, State and Local governments for programs and services benefiting members of the Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has funds available to provide for combined health services; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians desires to provide for these services under the authority of P.L. 93-638 contract with the Indian Health Service; and,
- WHEREAS, the Administrative Policy Board has been conferred subject-matter jurisdiction to authorize the preparation of proposals and to negotiate all grants and contracts on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band pursuant to Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 21.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille LAcs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve and authorize the submission of a P.L. 93-638 contract proposal to the Indian Health Service for F.Y. 1988-89.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we the Administrative Policy Board hereunto have recommended to set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to thie resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for consurrence.
