RESOLUTION 02-03-52-88

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is the duly recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly's number one priority is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly has contracted for educational services under P.L. 93-638, and;

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Nay Ah Shing School Board has met and has passed a motion to apply for a grant under P.L. 100-297, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereto, and;

WHEREAS, the expiration date of the authorities granted by the resolution shall be in effect until rescinded by the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly, and;

WHEREAS, P.L. 100-297 allows tribes to switch their contracts to a grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly does request to receive a grant on October 1, 1988 for School Operations, Chapter One, Operations and Maintenance, and P.L. 94-142, which are not contracted under P.L. 93-638.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
