RESOLUTION 02-03-42-88

A RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM (CSBG/MEOG).

- WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is a need to assist low income families residing on the Mille Lacs Reservation with various services; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is interested in applying for funds under the Community Services Block Grant Program (CSBG/MEOG) for fiscal year 1989 to assist those eligible low-income households; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is hereby authorizing the Administrative Policy Board to apply on their behalf.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians authorizes the Administrative Policy Board to implement, coordinate, plan and administer the aforementioned program on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto have recommended to set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
