RESOLUTION 02-04-55-88

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS IN SUPPORT OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF OJIBWE CAREER EDUCATION VAN PROJECT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully authorized to act in behalf of its members, and;
- WHEREAS, Indian students in Districts I, II and III are not provided with the information, skills and motivation needed to plan for their future careers, and;
- WHEREAS, funds are available through the Vocational Education Program for Indian Tribes and Indian Organizations to provide a comprehensive vocational education plan, and;
- WHEREAS, the basic goal of this proposed project is to purchase, equip and operate a career education van designed to serve the Districts I, II and III Indian students.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby offers its full support to the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Career Education Van Project.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
