RESOLUTION 02-02-03-88

A SPECIAL REVENUE RESOLUTION GRANTING DISBURSEMENT FROM THE GENERAL SALES TAXATION ACCOUNT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE OPERATING ACCOUNT OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Finance respectively requests authorization to disburse four thousand two hundred seventy seven dollars and seven cents (\$ 4,277.07) from the General Sales Taxation Account to the Administrative Operating Account to cover the following: two thousand four hundred seventy seven dollars and thirty two cents to Ziontz & Associates, five hundred dollars and no cents to First State Bank of Onamia, one hundred eighty dollars to Pow Wow Bingo for pull tabs, three hundred eighteen dollars and no cents for airfare, four hundred fifty one dollars and seventy five cents for out-of-state travel and per diem, and three hundred fifty dollars and no cents for tuition; pursuant to the provisions of Band Statute 1085-MLC-37, Section 66.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Harry D. Simons, Commissioner of Finance be hereby authorized and directed to disburse four thousand two hundred seventy seven dollars and seven cents from the General Sales Taxation Account to the Administrative Operating Account.
