RESOLUTION 02-04-60-88

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] wishes the lease of a lot on lands under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for the purpose of a homesite, and;

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Tract 4 defined by the Johnson Survey (4-21-86) Sandy Lake addition SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 22, TWP 50 N Range 27 West.

WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective September 7<sup>th</sup> 1988 for the purpose of financing this home.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective September 7<sup>th</sup>, 1988.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that lessee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1988 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
