RESOLUTION 02-02-14-88

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS FOR CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to contract with the State of Minnesota for chemical dependency funds, and;

WHEREAS, funds are available through the State of Minnesota to provide programs and services to address chemical dependency needs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) approves the terms of the grant contract entered into between the State of Minnesota and the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for the period through June 30th, 1988.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians authorizes its Commissioner of Administration and Commissioner of Health and Human Services to sign contracts in behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the hand of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
