RESOLUTION 02-04-11-89

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TERMINATION OF LAND LEASE  
AGREEMENT FOR [REDACTED]

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc., and;
- WHEREAS, the Court of Central Jurisdiction has ordered that this land lease agreement (Resolution 15-81) be hereby terminated, and;
- WHEREAS, the following land lease description is as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of the north one-half of the northeast quarter, thence north 629.53 feet, thence east 1,398.7 feet, thence north 466 feet, point of beginning, thence north 200 feet, thence east 100 feet, thence south 200 feet, thence west 100 feet, to point of beginning in Section 28, Township 43 North, Range 27 West.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians terminates this land lease agreement effective November 10th, 1988.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly In legislative council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 10th day of November, 1988 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
