RESOLUTION 03-02-63-89

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE RELINQUISHMENT OF BONNIE J. BEARHEART AS A MEMBER OF THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE (MILLE LACS BAND).

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) has screened the following applications for relinquishment, and;

WHEREAS, Bonnie J. Bearheart has signed a relinquishment form with the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe as she relinquishes and surrenders any and all rights, titles and interest that she may have in any undistributed property and assets of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, and;

WHEREAS, information received by the St. Croix Tribal Council of Wisconsin states their Tribal Council will accept Bonnie J. Bearheart for membership providing that relinquishment is certified by the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) does determine that this relinquishment is proper and that the interest of the individual has been considered and that she does meet the requirements for membership with the St. Croix Tribal Council of Wisconsin and does approve the granting of the relinquishment for Bonnie J. Bearheart.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 28th day of July, 1989 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
