RESOLUTION 02-04-15-89

A RESOLUTION BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO APPROVE APPLICATION REQUESTING FUNDS UNDER THE INDIAN HIGHWAY SAFETY PROJECT (BIA).

- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has enacted Band Statute Chapter 52, and;
- WHEREAS, Chapter 52 provides for a Uniform Traffic Code for roads under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band, and;
- WHEREAS, the Band has appropriated funds to do law enforcement on the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the Band lacks the sufficient funds to meet the law enforcement needs of the Mille Lacs Band, and;
- WHEREAS, the traffic violations create severe safety problems and the loss of lives of Band members, and;
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has funds under the Indian Highway Safety Project to provide law enforcement to meet the needs of the Mille Lacs Band.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby authorizes the application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Indian Highway Safety Project.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the <u>29th</u> day of November, 1988 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of <u>2</u> FOR, <u>0</u> AGAINST, <u>0</u> SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
