RESOLUTION 03-02-83-89

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE REQUEST TO HAVE LAND PLACED IN TRUST STATUS FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully authorized to act on behalf of its members, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is the successor to the Treaty of 1855 (10 Stat. 1165), and;
- WHEREAS, the acquired land described as Government Lots 6 and 7 of Section 18, TWP 43N R27W, and;
- WHEREAS, this land is within the exterior boundaries of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Natural Resources for the Mille Lacs Band has submitted an application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to have said land placed in trust for the Mille Lacs Band, and;
- WHEREAS, said land would provide additional area for hunting, fishing, gathering, agricultural development, housing sites and economic development, and;
- WHEREAS, this land will be used to benefit the Mille Lacs Band.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians requests that these lands be placed in trust by the Bureau of Indian Affairs for the Mille Lacs Band with the United States of America as trustee.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
