RESOLUTION 03-02-80-89

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS REQUESTING TO RECEIVE MATURE CONTRACTS FOR GREAT LAKES INDIAN FISH AND WILDLIFE COMMISSION FOR FY 1990.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) number one priority is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) has submitted an application to plan, conduct and administer Bureau authorized programs pursuant to P.L. 93-638, as amended by P.L. 100-472 Indian Self Determination and Education Assistance Act Amendments of 1988, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is authorized to negotiate and execute the contracts and any amendments thereto, and;
- WHEREAS, the expiration date of the authorities granted by the resolution shall be in effect until rescinded by the Mille Lacs Band Assembly, and;
- WHEREAS, P.L. 93-638 as amended by P.L. 100-472 allows tribes to apply for mature contracts.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby request to receive a mature contract for Great Lakes Indian Fish & Wildlife for fiscal year 1990.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
