RESOLUTION 03-01-34-89

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS AUTHORI-ZING PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the publication of regulations in the federal register authorize participation of Indian tribes and Alaskan natives in the Community Development Block Grant Program funded by the United State Department of Housing and Urban Development, and;
- WHEREAS, the requirements of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians should reflect community participation, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has a desire to participate in the Community Development Block Grant Program.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has prepared and followed a written citizen participation plan and conducted a public hearing concerning the participation in the Community Development Block Grant Program pursuant to the regulatory requirements of the program.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Exefutive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
