## RESOLUTION 02-04-01-89

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSAL REQUESTING ASSISTANCE UNDER THE ADMINISTRA-TION FOR NATIVE AMERICANS (ANA).

- the comprehensive long range planning efforts of the Mille Lacs Band call WHEREAS. for economic development based on our culture and history, and;
- WHEREAS. the Minnesota Historical Society's committment to build a four million dollar Indian museum complex on our reservation presents a unique opportunity to spark a cultural/commercial complex fully within the goals of culturally based economic development, and;
- WHEREAS, the completion of several critical events will make the Museum Cultural/ Commercial Complex a reality, and;
- WHEREAS, these events include: 1) completing a marketing, feasibility, and financial analysis by a prominent & competent firm, 2) community education and planning of the project, 3) modification of the Bands corporate structure & relevant statutes to facilitate development and strengthen Band government, and 4) the eventual solicitation & negotiations with potential investors, along with the formation of a functional legal structure to govern the complex, and;
- WHEREAS, the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) provides funding for such projects as this one, which contributes to tribal economic self-sufficiency, strengthen tribal government, and contribute to the social development of Band members.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully and enthusiastically supports this application for ANA monies.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 11th day of October, 1988 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

In concurrence with the action of the Chief Executive, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the hand of the Speaker of Assembly to this resolution.
