RESOLUTION 03-01-24-89

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS INDIAN CHILD AND FAMILY SERVICES PROJECT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1989.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians and has the power and authority to make recommendations that would improve the economic status of its members, and;
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is to provide counseling, treatment and related family assistance services for Indian children and their families, and;
- WHEREAS, under Public Law 95-608, Title II Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has financial resources available to provide children, family and outreach services on the Mille Lacs Reservation.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the application for the Child and Family Services Project under Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
