RESOLUTION 03-02-73-89

A RESOLUTION GRANTING LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

- WHEREAS, [REDACTED] wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite, and;
- WHEREAS, tribal land lease are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Tract C, that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section 18, Township 43 North, Range 27 West, of the Fourth Principal Meridian, in Mille Lacs County Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at the Southeast corner of said Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter; thence North 00 degrees 53 minutes 33 seconds West 33.00 feet along the east line of said Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, thence North 89 degrees 58 minutes 27 seconds West 200.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence North 00 degrees 53 minutes 33 seconds West 200.00 feet; thence North 89 degrees 58 minutes 27 seconds West 200.00 feet; thence South 00 degrees 53 minutes 33 second East 200.00 feet; thence South 89 degrees 58 minutes 27 seconds East 200.00 feet to the point of beginning.
- WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective September 5th, 1989 for the purpose of financing this home.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective September 5th, 1989 at the rate of \$ 1.00 per term.
- BE TI FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within 12 months, if provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 5th day of September, 1989 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
