RESOLUTION 03-01-46-89

A RESOLUTION GRANTING LAND LEASE TO

for the purpose of a homesite, and;

WHEREAS,	wishes	the	lease	of	а	lot	on	the	Mille	Lacs	Reservation

- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of the south one-half of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, thence east 41.4 feet, thence north 54.4 feet, point of beginning, thence south 200 feet, thence east 100 feet, thence north 128 feet, thence running northwesterly parallel with road to point of beginning in Section 28, Township 43N, Range 27W, and;
- WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective April 18th, 1989 for the purpose of financing this home.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective April 18th, 1989 at the rate of \$ 1.00 per term.
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that lease will utilize the provisions of this resolution within 12 months, if provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 18th day of April, 1989 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
