## RESOLUTION 03-01-26-89

A RESOLUTION OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS FOR THE PURPOSE OF AN APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT AND/OR RENOVATE A DETENTION CENTER WITHIN INDIAN COUNTRY.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians desire to continue to strengthen and improve the government structure for its members, and
- WHEREAS, the ability to detain individuals in violation of Band Law is limited because of the lack of a detention center, and
- WHEREAS, the Band lacks the necessary financial resources to construct or renovate a detention center, and
- WHEREAS, the Band owns facility suitable for the renovation of a detention center, and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has funding for the construction and/or renovation of a detention center, and
- WHEREAS, the need for a detention center is important in the implementation of a meaningful and successful judical system.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians request funding for the construct and/or renovation of a detention center on the Mille Lacs Reservation.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
