RESOLUTION 02-04-20-89

A RESOLUTION FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO RECEIVE ADDITIONAL FUNDS UNDER PUBLIC LAW 93-638, CORE MANAGEMENT

- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has the responsibility to assist Tribal Government so as to further develop their self-determination efforts through Public Law 93-638, Indian Self-Determination Act, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians have unmet needs in the area of Core Management, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does not have the necessary funding to implement its Core Management needs, and;
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has funding available to support the Bands needs as they relate to Core Management.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve and adopt this resolution to support its Core Management needs and that this resolution will remain in effect until rescinded.
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Chief Executive or his designee develop and implement grants to support the Core Management needs of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution 02-04-20-89 was duly concurred with and adopted at a Special meeting of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 29th day of December, 1988 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
