RESOLUTION 03-02-85-89

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS AUTHORI-ZING THE MILLE LACS HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO EXECUTE AN INTER-GOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF JOBS AND TRAIN-ING FOR ENERGY ASSISTANCE MONIES AND RATIFYING THE TERMS OF SAID CONTRACT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Executive Branch have negotiated an intergovernmental agreement for Energy Assistance monies with the State Department of Jobs and Training, pursuant to powers granted in 2002-MLC-3, Section 4.02, and;
- WHEREAS, the Chief Executive has recommended ratification of the Energy Assistance Agreement to the Band Assembly pursuant to 2002-MLC-3, Section 7.04.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) approves the terms of the intergovernmental agreement between the State of Minnesota and the Mille Lacs Band for energy assistance monies.
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians authorizes its Commissioner of Administration and Commissioner of Human Services to sign contracts in behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the hand of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
