RESOLUTION 02-04-22-89

A RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP).

- WHEREAS, it has been determined that low-income families residing on the Mille Lacs Reservation spend a disproportionately high percentage of their income on energy; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is interested in applying for funds under the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) for fiscal year 1989 to assist eligible households; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band attempted to contract with the State Department of Jobs and Training for energy assistance monies, but the State attempted to require the Band to deny its sovereign status by imposing state administrative jurisdiction over Band members on Band lands; and
- whereas, the Mille Lacs Band refused to deny its sovereign status and viewed the imposition of additional state jurisdiction as an infringement on our self-governing rights and a violation of Minnesota statute 16B.06; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band refused to contract with the State of Minnesota for energy assistance money in view of this proposed infringement on sovereignty; and
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is hereby authorizing the Administrative Policy Board to apply on their behalf.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians authorizes the Administrative Policy Board to implement, coordinate, plan and administer the aforementioned program on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto have recommended to set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
