RESOLUTION 03-02-65-89

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROPOSAL REQUESTING CONTRACT FUNDS FROM THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to contract with federal, state and local government for programs and services benefitting members of the Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has funds available to provide for combined health services, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians desires to provide for these services under the authority of P.L. 93-638 contract with the Indian Health Service, and;
- WHEREAS, the Administrative Policy Board has conferred subject matter jurisdiction to authorize the preparation of proposals and to negotiate all grants and contract on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band pursuant to Band Statute 2002-MLC-3, Section 9.02.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve and authorize the submission of a P.L. 93-638 contract proposal to the Indian Health Service for FY 1989-1990.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto have cause to set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
