RESOLUTION 03-01-45-89

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TERMINATION OF LAND LEASE AGREEMENT FOR [REDACTED]

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc, and;
- WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has requested that her land lease agreement be terminated for the following land lease description:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the south one-half of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, thence east 41.4 feet, thence north 54.4 feet, point of beginning, thence south 200 feet, thence east 100 feet, thence north 128 feet, thence running northwesterly parallel with road to point of beginning in Section 28, Township 43N, Range 27W.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians terminates this land lease agreement effective April 18th, 1989.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 18th day of April, 1989 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
