RESOLUTION 03-04-06-90

A CONTINUING RESOLUTION FOR THE GOVERNMENTAL STRUCTURE OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1989 WHICH IS IN LIEU OF A FORMAL APPROPRIATIONS STATUTE.

- WHEREAS, Ordinance 02-82, Section 8 mandates the appropriation of all Band revenue prior to the commencement of a new fiscal year, and;
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has not passed formal appropriations to continue the essential services to the enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band, and;
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians continues to review all necessary financial information in order to ensure the financial integrity of the Band.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby authorizes the continuance of the following program for a period of thirty days (30) to expire on midnight November 30, 1989, said expenditure shall not exceed the amount listed:

Administrative Operating Account

\$ 12,106.00

Should this program fail to have sufficient cash fund balance to continue operations, immediate program shut-down shall occur.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
