A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO

- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Aitken County (Turner Township) that part of SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 22, T 50 N, R 23 W, defined as Tract 10, and;
- WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective April 25th, 1990 for the purpose of a homesite.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective April 25th, 1990.
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that lease will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 25th day of April, 1990 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, AGAINST, SILENT.
