## RESOLUTION 03-04-13-90

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE SUPPORT AND FUNDING OF THE PUBLIC HOUSING DRUG ELIMINATION PROGRAM FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) number one priority is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, funds are available through the Department of Housing and Urban Development under the Public Housing Drug Elimination Act of 1988 (P.L. 100-690), and;
- WHEREAS, the Public Housing Drug Elimination Program will be a cooperative effort sponsored by the Mille Lacs Housing Authority and the Mille Lacs Reservation Department of Law Enforcement, and;
- WHEREAS, the basic goal of this proposed project is to reduce drug consumption and deter accompanying drug related crimes that occur in and around Indian Public Housing on the Mille Lacs Reservation.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby approves and authorizes the submission of an application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a Public Housing Drug Elimination Program and supports their efforts to assist young people in becoming drug-free.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto recommends the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
