RESOLUTION 04-02-78-90

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO IMPLEMENT THE "SPECIAL CHILD ABUSE INITIATIVE PROGRAM" UNDER THE HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES ADMINISTRATION.

- WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully authorized to act on behalf of its members, and;
- WHEREAS, The number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has funds available for the implementation of the "Special Child Abuse Initiative Program" on the Mille Lacs Reservation under the Health & Human Services Administration.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby approves funding for the "Special Child Abuse Initiative Program".
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, That the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Health & Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, We, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
