RESOLUTION 04-01-71-90

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE OPTOMETRY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly recognized governing body of the Mille lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully authorized to act on behalf of its members, and;

WHEREAS, the number priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for its members, and;

WHEREAS, there are funds available from Indian Health Service under its Tribal Demonstration Project for Diabetes and Mental Health Services for American Indians for the purposes indicated in the attached proposal entitled "The Year of the Eye: Diabetes Program", and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians respectfully requests funding from Indian Health Services to provide retinopathy screenings for diabetic patients who utilize optometry services at the Nei-ia-shing Clinic;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby approves and offers it support to the submission of an application to Indian Health Service.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
