RESOLUTION 04-02-89-90

A RESOLUTION GRANTING RELINQUISHMENT OF CHARLES A. HOULE, JR. AS A MEMBER OF THE MILLE LACS BAND.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) has screened the following application for relinquishment; and,

WHEREAS, Charles J. Houle, Jr. has signed a relinquishment form with the Mille Lacs Band as he relinquishes and surrenders any and all rights, titles, and interest that he may have in any undistributed property and assets of the Mille Lacs Band; and,


WHEREAS, information received by the Fond Du Lac Reservation Business Committee of Cloquet, Minnesota, states their Tribal Council will accept Charles J. Houle, Jr. for membership providing relinquishment is certified by the Mille Lacs Band.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does determine that this relinquishment is proper and that the interest of the individual has been considered and that he does meet the requirements for membership with the Fond Du Lac Reservation Business Committee of Cloquet, Minnesota and does approve the granting of relinquishment of Charles J. Houle, Jr.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the 31st day of July, 1990 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
