RESOLUTION 03-04-08-90

A RESOLUTION GRANTING LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] wishes the lease of lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite, and;

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Lot 13, Block 1, Vineland Hills, as described by Anthony E. Kenick on March 9, 1982.

WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective November 9th, 1989 for the purpose of a homesite.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective November 9th, 1989 at the rate of \$ 1.00 per term.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that lessee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within 12 months, if provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 9th day of November, 1989 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
