- WHEREAS, wish the lease of a lot on lands under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for the purpose of a homesite, and;
- WHEREAS. tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land under the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- said land is described as follows: Lot 6, Block 1 as defined by the Vine-WHEREAS, land Hills Map as part of the N 1/2, NE 1/4, Section 28, Township 43 N, Range 27 W, and;
- WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective May 24, 1990 for the purpose of a homesite.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective May 24, 1990.
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met lease will than revert back to the Band.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 24 day of May, 1990 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
