RESOLUTION 04-01-25-90

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS FOR CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY OUTREACH PROJECT WITH THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to contract with the State of Minnesota for Youth Chemical Dependency Outreach funds, and;
- WHEREAS, funds are available through the State of Minnesota for an Outreach Project to provide information, referral and educational services to the Districts II and III Indian Communities of the Mille Lacs Reservation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) approves the terms of the grant contract entered into between the State of Minnesota and the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for Fiscal Year 1991.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.


