RESOLUTION 04-02-103-90

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEBT REDEMPTION AND COMPLETION OF THE NEGOTIATION/IMPLEMENTATION PHASE OF THE SELF-GOVERNANCE DEMONSTRATION PROJECT.

- WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully authorized to act on behalf of its members, and;
- WHEREAS, In 1987, the Mille Lacs Band entered into the Self-Governance Demonstration Project, pursuant to Public Law 93-638, as amended by Public Law 100-472, and:
- WHEREAS, Due to the notification by the Bureau of Indian Affairs of a funding limitation of \$20,000.00 for the negotiation-phase of the Self-Governance Demonstration Project, we, the Band Assembly, on March 29th, 1990, passed Resolution 04-01-46-90 as a request for access to a grant of "at least \$20,000.00" to complete the Self-Governance Demonstration Project, and;
- WHEREAS, On July 3, 1990, the Mille Lacs Band entered into a Compact of Self-Governance with the Department of the Interior of the United States of America, and;
- WHEREAS, The Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band has found that the award of \$20,000.00 was wholly insufficient for the purpose of performing all of the necessary functions directly related to the negotiation/implementation phase of the Self-Governance Demonstration Project, and;
- WHEREAS, The Band Assembly has determined that the successful completion of the Self-Governance Demonstration Project is a priority which will cause increased funding to be absolutely imperative.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby requests additional funding from the Secretary of the Department of the Interior in the amount of \$50,000.00 for the the following purposes:
 - a) Debt redemption in the amount of \$29,382.40, an amount which was expended over and above the

grant of \$20,000.00 upon the performance of all such functions as were necessary throughout the negotiation phase of the Self-Governance Demonstration Project thus far.

- b) Projected expenses directly related to the Compact of Self-Governance in the amount of \$20,651.60 for the purpose of successful completion of all such functions as are are mandated by the compact or necessary for the successful provision thereof.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto have set the signature of the Chief Executive to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
