RESOLUTION 04-01-72-90

A RESOLUTION GRANTING RIGHT OF WAY ACROSS LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO THE MILLE LACS ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTRICAL SERVICES.

- WHEREAS, Mille Lacs Electric is desirous of obtaining a right of way for the use on the premises in connection with said land leases, and,
- WHEREAS, Band Statute 1094-MLC-47, designates rules and regulations governing the issuance of right of way across lands under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;
- WHEREAS, pursuant to this statutory authority, the Commissioner of Natural Resources has reviewed the request of the Mille Lacs Electric and does hereby recommend that the Chief Executive approve said right of way request.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the request for a right of way across lands herein described as: beginning at Highway Station 54+30 of Gahbow road, as described by the bureau of Indian Affairs federal road project 410-50(2), hence south 33 to point of origin, hence south 100 ft., hence west 225 feet,, hence north 100 feet, hence 225 east to the point of origin.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Commissioner of Natural Resources do hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to Band Assembly for concurrence.
