Resolution 04-01-27-90

A RESOLUTION BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS INCORPORATING THE 1989 UPDATE TO THE BAND'S OVERALL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN (OEDP) INTO THE EXISTING OEDP, AS THE BAND'S OFFICIAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

- Whereas, The Mille Lacs Band Assembly (a.k.a. Reservation Business Committee) is the duly recognized body of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- Whereas, The Mille Lacs Band Assembly has identified the need to promote the economic and social well being of the Mille Lacs people as a key priority for Band government; and
- Whereas, The Mille Lacs Band Assembly in 1983 adopted the Band's OEDP as the Band's official economic development plan and mandated annual updates be made to this plan; and
- Whereas, The Mille Lacs Band Assembly has reviewed the 1989 update to the Band's OEDP and recognizes that the steps outlined in this report will result in improving the social and economic welfare of the Mille Lacs Indian Reservation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby accept the 1989 update to the OEDP and incorporate this update into the OEDP and reaffirms that this document is the official economic development plan for the Mille Lacs Reservation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
