RESOLUTION 04-01-37-90

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

- WHEREAS, [REDACTED] wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for a purpose of a homesite, and;
- WHEREAS, a tribal land lease is needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: beginning at Highway Station 54+30 of Garbow road, as described by the Bureau of Indian Affairs federal road project 410-50(2), hence south 33 to point of origin, hence south 100 ft, hence west 225 ft, hence north 100 ft, hence 225 east to the point of origin.
- WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective March 8th, 1990 for the purpose of financing a home, and;
- WHEREAS, said land has been abandon for a period greater than one year, voiding any former land assignment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective March 8th, 1990, at the rate of \$ 1.00 per term.

BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, is provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th day of March, 1990 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
