RESOLUTION 04-01-23-90

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF PROPOSAL FOR A DRUG & ALCOHOL AFTERCARE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully authorized to act on behalf of its members, and;

WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians respectfully requests funding from the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation to fund a two year culturally specific drug and alcohol aftercare program on the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, the magnitude of substance abuse on the Mille Lacs Reservation implies an important need for drug and alcohol aftercare services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby approves and offers its support to the submission of an application to the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation for a Drug & Alcohol Aftercare Program.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
