## RESOLUTION 04-01-36-90

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS IN SUPPORT OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY'S APPLICATION TO CONVERT THE MUTUAL HELP PROJECTS TO A LOW RENTAL PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, fully authorized to act on behalf of its members, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority has submitted an application to convert 19 of the 20 units in the Mutual Help Project to a Low Rental Program, and;
- WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development requests a tribal resolution supporting the conversion application.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby offers its full support to the Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority to convert 19 of the 20 units in the Mutual Help Project to a Low Rental Program.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 8th day of March, 1990, at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
