RESOLUTION 03-04-03-90

A SPECIAL REVENUE RESOLUTION GRANTING DISBURSEMENT FROM THE GENERAL SALES TAXATION ACCOUNT OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Finance respectfully requests authorization to disburse one thousand dollars and no cents (\$ 1,000.00) from the General Sales Taxation Account to start up a cultural fund for the elderly, pursuant to the provisions of Band Statute 1085-MLC-37, Section 66.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Polly Williams, Commissioner of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to disburse one thousand dollars and no cents from the General Sales Taxation Account to start up a cultural fund for the elderly.
