RESOLUTION 04-03-87-91

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND SUPPORTING EFFORTS IN OBTAINING FUNDING FROM THE INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE FOR THE SPECIAL MENTAL HEALTH INITIATIVE FOR A MEN'S INTERVENTION PROJECT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is concerned for its enrolled members; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for all its members; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is desirous in obtaining funding from Indian Health Service for the Special Mental Health Initiative for a Men's Intervention Project.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly supports the submission of a proposal to Indian Health Service to fund this worthwhile project.
- BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
