RESOLUTION 04-03-105-91

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE FISCAL YEAR 1992 SELF GOVERNANCE DEMONSTRATION PROJECT FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly's priority is to improve the overall quality of life for its members; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band is a current participant in the Self Governance Demonstration Project, who has a signed compact with the Department of Interior for fiscal year 1992.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly approves the fiscal year 1992 breakout and distribution amounts as proposed by the Leech Lake Tribal Council for the Mille Lacs Band Self-Governance Demonstration Project.
