RESOLUTION 04-02-27-91

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A PROPOSAL TO THE BLANDIN FOUNDATION FOR NUTRITIONAL SERVICES FOR ELDERLY NATIVE AMERICANS FOR THE HUMAN SERVICES ADMINISTRATION OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully authorized to act on behalf of its members; and,

WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for the people of the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully supports the Human Services Administration in its efforts to improve the services to the elderly members of the Mille Lacs Reservation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby supports a proposal for grant assistance to the Blandin Foundation for Nutritional Services for Elderly Native Americans.
