RESOLUTION 04-03-103-91

A RESOLUTION GRANTING RELINQUISHMENT OF [REDACTED] AS
A MEMBER OF THE MILLE LACS BAND.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians fully authorized to act on behalf of its members; and,


WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has signed a relinquishment form with the Mille Lacs Band as she relinquishes and surrenders any and all rights, titles, and interest that she may have in any undistributed property and assets of the Mille Lacs Band; and,

WHEREAS, information received by the Leech Lake Reservation Business Committee of Cass Lake, Minnesota, states their tribal council will accept [REDACTED] for membership providing relinquishment is certified by the Mille Lacs Band.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does determine that this relinquishment is proper and that the interest of the individual has been considered and that she does meet the requirements for membership with the Leech Lake Reservation Business Committee of Cass Lake, Minnesota and does approve the granting of relinquishment of [REDACTED]

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a special session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the 24th day of July, 1991, at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
