## RESOLUTION 04-03-88-91

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND TO APPROVE AN APPLICATION REQUESTING FUNDING UNDER THE INDIAN HIGHWAY SAFETY PROJECT (BIA).

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly is concerned for its enrolled members; and,
- WHEREAS, the number one priority of the Band Assembly is to improve the overall quality of life for all its members; and,
- WHEREAS, the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1973 (P.L. 93-87) provides for U. S. Department of Transportation has funding available to assist Indian Tribes in financing highway traffic safety projects which are designed to reduce high numbers of traffic accidents and their resulting fatalities, injuries, and property damage within Indian communities; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is desirous in obtaining funds such funds.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly supports the submission of a proposal to the Bureau of Indian Affairs Indian Highway Safety Program.
- BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
