RESOLUTION 04-04-118-91

A RESOLUTION GRANTING RIGHT OF WAY ACROSS LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO THE MILLE LACS ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTRICAL SERVICES.

- WHEREAS, Mille Lacs Electric is desirous of obtaining a right of way for the use on the premises in connection with said land leases; and,
- WHEREAS, Band Statute 1094-MLC-47, designates rules and regulations governing the issuance of right of way across lands under the jurisdiction of the Band; and,
- WHEREAS, pursuant to this statutory authority, the Commissioner of Natural Resources has reviewed the request of the Mille Lacs Electric and does hereby recommend that the Chief Executive approve said right of way request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the request for an electric right of way of 40 feet for a service line across U.S. Trust Lands described as: starting at existing power line hence west along the south side of the west side road through S 1/2 of the NE 1/4 and S 1/2 of the NW 1/4 to existing housing unit (George Bedausky) all in Section 29 T43N, R24 W.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, John W. Sedell, Commissioner of Natural Resources do hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
