RESOLUTION 04-04-115-91

	A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO
WHEREAS,	wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of homesite; and,
WHEREAS,	a tribal land lease is needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land for the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
WHEREAS,	said land is described as follows: that part of Section 17, Township 43N, Range 27W starting at the intersection of approach and the centerline of Highway #169, hence a distance north down the centerline of driveway a distance of 300 feet to the point of beginnings, hence due east a distance of approximately 150 feet to the the east section line of section 17, hence south a distance of 250 feet along said section line, hence due west to the centerline of driveway, hence north along said centerline to point of beginning; and,
WHEREAS,	the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective September 10th, 1991 for the purpose of homesite.
NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective September 10, 1991.
BE IT FURTH	ER RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, lease will then revert back to the Band.
BE IT FURTH	ER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that this lease shall be null and void should the lease abandon or vacate the above described property for more than thirty days without prior approval of the Band Assembly.
WE DO HEREI	at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the pth day of September, 1991 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 2 AGAINST, 2 SILENT.
