## RESOLUTION 04-04-113-91

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPLICATION BY THE CORPORATE COMMISSION ON BEHALF OF THE GRAND CASINO MANAGEMENT CORPORATION TO THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR AN ACCESS DRIVEWAY PERMIT

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Corporate Commission is a political subdivision, empowered by the Band Assembly to act in the best interest for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Corporate Commission, on behalf of the Grand Casino Management Corporation has applied to the Minnesota Department of Transportation (application dated August 29, 1991) for an Access Driveway Permit (right turn-in only) to be located approximately 656' south of the Ne-Ah-Shing Road; and,
- WHEREAS, the proposed Access Driveway (right turn-in only) will relieve the Highway #169 southbound traffic congestion and improve the public safety in and around the Grand Casino Mille Lacs; and,
- WHEREAS, the lands immediately north of the proposed right turn-in lane are allotments held in trust by the United States of America; and,
- WHEREAS, these same allotments are in fractional heirship and some heirs will not agree to have their allotment used for commercial roadway.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the application for the right turn-in lane to be developed for improved traffic flow and the interest of public safety.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on the 9th day of September, 1991, at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of \_\_3\_FOR, \_\_0\_AGAINST, \_\_0\_SILENT.
