RESOLUTION 04-03-41-91

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS FOR YOUTH CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY CONTRACTS WITH THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.

- WHEREAS the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to contract with the State of Minnesota for Youth Chemical Dependency funds; and,
- WHEREAS, funds are available through the State of Minnesota to provide programs and services to address youth chemical dependency needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly approves the terms of the grant contract entered into between the State of Minnesota and the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for Fiscal Years 1992 and 1993.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Human Services are authorized to sign on behalf of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
