RESOLUTION 04-03-70-91

A RESOLUTION FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR-BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS TO ESTABLISH A PAYROLL DEPARTMENT WITH SUCH FUNDS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee (Band Assembly) is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the payroll department of any organization must have qualified personnel to insure the smooth operation of said department; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band currently has limited funds to support qualified personnel to meet the demands of the current payroll system; and,
- WHEREAS, the Department of Interior-Bureau of Indian Affairs has discretionary funds available to those potential applicants meeting their criteria.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly does hereby support proposal efforts to obtain Department of the Interior-Bureau of Indian Affairs funding to support a payroll department for the Mille Lacs Reservation.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
